**CLARIFICATIONS/CORRIGENDUM FOR PRE-BID MEETING HELD FOR  
HANDLING OF CARGO AT ICD/TNPM, CHENNAI, SOUTHERN REGION.**

Pre-Bid Meeting was held on 10.04.2018 at 15.00 hrs at CONCOR, ICD/TNPM, Chennai, to clarify the doubts if any, before the bidders submit their final bid. The tender has been called vide above e-tender notice for Handling of Cargo at ICD/TNPM, Chennai.

During the above meeting the representatives has raised the following queries and the same was clarified.

Sl. No	Clarifications sought by the bidder	Reply/clarifications of CONCOR
1.	One of the bidder sought clarification that as per para 2 of chapter IV of tender document, rate revision Clause is available in tender only for diesel, whether rate revision is possible whenever there is a revision in the minimum wages.	Tender conditions will prevail.
2.	The bidder sought clarification with regard to the closure of approach road/bridge to CONCOR terminal and sought CONCOR's assurance for guaranteed minimum volume of 1200 Teu Per Month/payment of Rs 8 Lakhs per month	Tender conditions will prevail. Refer clause no.2.5.1 of chapter –III and clause no.8.1 of chapter-IV.
3.	The bidder sought clarification as to whether the separate rate can be considered for handling charges for export cargo arriving by Container and Vehicle.	Tender conditions will prevail.
4.	The bidder sought clarification as to whether the additional rate can be considered for Shifting of cargo inside the warehouse since incurring extra diesel and manpower involved.	Tender conditions will prevail.
5.	The bidder sought clarification as to whether the forklift with catcher arrangement can be allowed on requirement basis with advance notice from CONCOR.	Tender conditions will prevail. Refer clause no.3 of chapter-III.
