**CLARIFICATIONS/CORRIGENDUM FOR PRE-BID MEETING HELD FOR ROAD TRANSPORTATION OF CONTAINERS & CARGO AT ICD/WFD, BENGALURU, SOUTHERN REGION.**

**E-Tender notice no. CON/SR/WFD/TPT/0818/11**

Pre-Bid Meeting was held on 03.09.2018 at 15.00 hrs at CONCOR, ICD/WFD, Bengaluru, to clarify the doubts if any, before the bidders submit their final bid. The tender has been called vide above e-tender notice for Road Transportation of Containers & Cargo at ICD/WFD, Bengaluru.

During the above meeting the representatives has raised the following queries and the same was clarified.

Sr. No.	Clarifications sought by the bidder	Reply/clarifications of CONCOR
1.	One of the bidder asked, why 2 (Two) nos of CBT's have been asked in Tender.	The number of CBTs asked is as per the anticipated volume at the terminal to transport LCL Export/Import cargo.
2.	One of the bidder sought what will be the transit time to various ports for container trailers as the same is not mentioned in the Tender.	Kindly refer Chapter III, para vii, the transit time shall be notified by the Terminal Manager/CONCOR once the Tender is awarded considering prevailing circumstances of transportation to various streams.
3.	One of the bidder asked, what document will be considered as proof of delivery of containers at gateway port?	Refer Chapter III, para 7.8, the contractor has to submit copy of EIR being exchanged at Gateway port as proof of delivery.
4.	The bidder asked are detention charges payable to the contractor by CONCOR for trailers getting detained at gateway ports.	Kindly refer tender conditions as per Chapter IV, detention charge is payable only in case of FDS/FS.
5.	Are non-encumbered trailers allowed to do private work?	As per Chapter III, para 3(c) of tender document, non-encumbered trailers can not undertake private works in the ICD/WFD or in nearby CONCOR terminals.
6.	One of the bidder asked, what is time limit for completion of job orders and how many job orders have to be fulfilled in a day? Is penalty applicable if more than 16 job orders are not carried out on a single day?	The conditions pertaining to job order , its compliance shall be dealt as per para 5of Chapter III. Bidders are requested to kindly refer the tender document and para mentioned above.
7.	The bidder asked, does the contractor need to have separate insurance for covering containers and cargo which is transported?	Bidders are requested to refer Chapter III, para 7.3 regarding obtaining insurance.
8.	One of the bidder asked, what is the procedure for submission of the bills.	Bidders are requested to refer Chapter IV, para 15 with regard billing procedure.

**The other terms and conditions of the above e-tender remains the same.**
